FITNESS TIP

A Little Dehydration Has a Big Impact. If you want to perform at your best in sport or exercise, you've got to keep your body adequately hydrated throughout your activity. The American College of Sports Medicine recommends the following guidelines for keeping the body hydrated:

BEFORE PHYSICAL ACTIVITY:

Drink at least 16 ounces of fluid about two hours beforehand.

DURING ACTIVITY:

Drink 5 to 10 ounces every 15 to 20 minutes.

AFTER ACTIVITY:

Drink 16 ounces for each pound of body weight lost during activity.

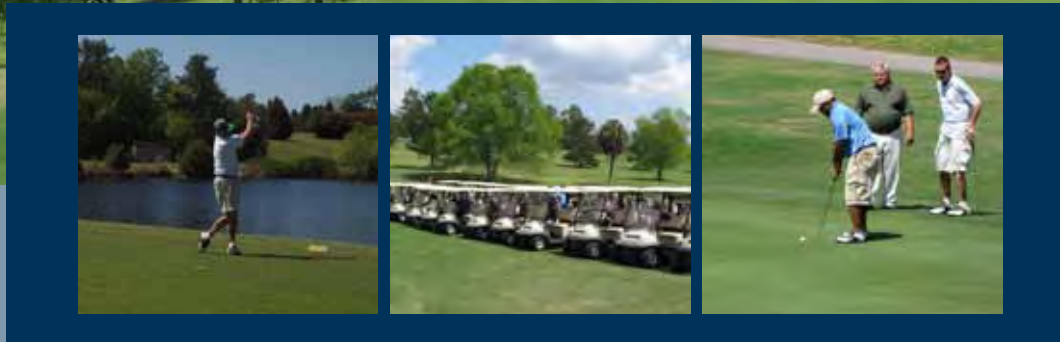
